

For years YMCA North has provided a safe and secure environment, where kids can be and enjoy their out-of-school hours. The pandemic has taken a toll on all of us, especially parents who are now busier than before with added commitments adjusting to the new normal.

Y Out of School Care programme aims to support every parent by not only being 'a convenient care service', but a safe haven where every child's development is supported and learning recognised.

With brand new activities for 2022 designed to keep primary and intermediateaged children engaged and active, Y Out of School Care programme is based on three fundamentals - Being Active, Creative & Learning Life Skills. Our programmes are focused to ensure the time kids spend with us, brings the best outcome for them. As part of this initiative, we have introduced 5 new zones into our popular Y Out of School Care programme curriculum. This means no term is going to be the same keeping kids always engaged and entertained during sessions.



ZONE 1 Engineering Wonders

Grabbing children's natural passion for exploring how things work, Engineering Wonders brings the wonder of STEAM to life. A channel for curiosity that children can use to simply enjoy themselves, or open their minds. With the help of science, technology, and engineering - this zone focuses on exploring and finding answers in a fun and hands-on way! 




ZONE 5 Super Artists

The programme may change due to changing government restrictions. If we move into a lockdown, then a credit for future programmes OR refund will be available.

All YMCA staff are vaccinated, and will be wearing masks inside.

Please note that our excursions are likely to go to places operating under the COVID protection framework. This means that if your child is over 12 years old, they will need to bring a mask in order to attend the excursion.

Children must be signed in and out by a parent / guardian. Parents / guardians may be asked to show ID when collecting children – please do not be offended as it is for the safety of the children. For children making their own way to from the programme we require an Unaccompanied Child Form to be completed.

If your child requires any special medications, these must be signed in and given to our programme staff. A medical form must be completed and medication must be in its original packaging showing the child's name and medicine type. All children that have an ongoing medical condition (e.g. nut allergy / asthma) must provide the programme with a current Medical/Allergy Management Plan.

Children need to bring with them their lunch, snacks, refillable drink bottle, sunhat and raincoat each day. An SPF 30+ sunscreen will be provided by the YMCA and applied prior to outdoor activities Sept to April. If your child requires a specific sunscreen, please label it with your child's name and send it along with your child each day.

We take due care with children's belongings but accept no responsibility for lost or misplaced items. Please name your children's belongings so any left behind items may be returned.
